

POLICY DESCRIPTION:

BE IT RESOLVED that Council of the RM of Elton (Elton) amend the Dust Control Policy on municipal roads **effective May 11, 2021** as follows:

PURPOSE

The Dust Control Program offers Elton residents and property owners the opportunity to apply dust control on rural roads in front of residences, farmstead and/or private laneways. Dust control involves the application of a dust control suppressant to gravel roads to minimize dust.

PROCEDURE

The Municipality will determine the dust control suppressant used. Approved dust control products are Calcium Chloride and Magnesium Chloride. A request for approval of any other dust control suppressant must be approved by Council.

The Municipality will advertise on the Municipal Website, Facebook page, and email list in order to determine the level of interest in the Dust Control Program each year.

Residents/Ratepayers will be responsible to arrange for application of dust control at their property each year by contacting the Municipal Office.

A Dust Control Application/Waiver form and full payment **must** be received in the Municipal Office by **APRIL 30th of the current year**.

Once application and payment are received the Municipality will provide stakes for the applicant to mark out the requested length. Public Works will verify measurement prior to the dust control being applied.

Public Works will determine the preparation of the site. Preparation depends on their priority of work, weather conditions, contractors' schedules, and gravelling program.

POLICY

Rates will apply to all residential, farmstead and/or private laneways.

Cost of the dust control suppressant is determined annually by the Municipality. Contact Municipal Office for the most up to date pricing.

A minimum of 100ft is required and increments of 50ft thereafter.

Where possible, Elton will provide road gravel in the area to receive dust control prior to the application of the dust control product, as per its annual gravelling program (this does not apply to private laneways)

The Municipality reserves the right to perform such maintenance procedures as it deems necessary on the treated portion of the roadway. Although the Municipality will attempt to minimize the adverse effect of these operations on the treated portion of the roadway, the Municipality will not accept liability for any restoration required.

The Municipality reserves the right to perform its "regular" maintenance procedures as it deems necessary on the treated portion of the roadway after the **1st day of October** each year in order to prepare the roadways for the winter season.

The Municipality accepts no responsibility for the effectiveness of the dust control suppressant. Once the suppressant is applied to the road surface no refunds will be made.

The Municipality accepts no responsibility for the ongoing maintenance of the dust control.

The Municipality has the right to refund all payments in the event that there are not enough requests for a truck load.

A resident may contact an alternate contractor and use a dust control suppressant approved by Council. All information regarding the contractor, location, length, and product used etc. must be included in the application to the Municipality no later than April 30th of the current year. Preparation depends on their priority of work, weather conditions, contractors' schedules, and gravelling program. The Municipal Dust Control Program will take priority over individual contracted work.

If a dust control suppressant is applied without consent of the municipality and annual maintenance and/or repairs are required Elton will not be responsible for the dust control suppressant costs.
